Community Risk Reduction Plan

- **Detection of Acute Elevated Risk** (Referral Forms)
- **Share Information** (Consent/Threshold)
- **Mobilize Assets**
- **Deploy Rapid Intervention**
- Updates

Evaluation of the Plan

- Data Collection and Analyzation
- 58% the 1st year
- 70% the 2nd year and continues to rise
- Constant Evaluation of groups and services change as different groups present different people
