

Regional Fire Operations Coordination Group

A multi-jurisdictional meeting was held today to discuss coordinated communications, planning and the staffing of the EOC.

- Several Type 2 members within the region will begin working in positions to assist the EOC and Chief Cates will be the Fire Liaison to EOC.
- Daily situational status reports that will be sent by each department on a modified 209 form to Chief Jefferies and he will compile updates for the region.
- The Type II team members should be operational in the next 48 hours.
- Additionally, a JIC will be meeting today at 1600 hours.

These are the latest steps towards improving regional readiness and begin to smooth out through developing joint IAPs and definitions.

We are looking at expanding to full automatic aid with District 9 and will let you know when that will go live. Be prepared to respond into D9 for all call types and have D9 respond into our district for all call types.
