

Visitors to Everett Fire Stations:

Because of the coronavirus outbreak in Everett and Snohomish County, **VISITORS ARE NOT ALLOWED INSIDE**. For the safety of our responders and the public, please follow these steps if you still need to speak with the firefighters:

1. After ringing the doorbell, please step back at least six (6) feet from the door.
2. Inform the firefighter if you have a fever, cough, or are suffering from other respiratory distress.

IF NO ONE COMES TO THE DOOR AND THIS IS AN EMERGENCY, CALL 9-1-1

If this is not an emergency (and no one comes to the door), call 425-407-3999

If you are here for a blood pressure check, please inform the firefighter who answers and they will take your blood pressure outside of the station.

Firefighters may be wearing gloves, goggles, and a mask while assisting you. This is a standard precaution during this outbreak and is meant to protect both your safety and ours.
